"The purpose of this church shall be to bind together followers of Jesus Christ, for the object of sharing in the worship of God and in making His will dominant in the lives of men and women, especially as that will is set forth in the life and teachings of Jesus Christ."

Pentecost with Romans 8:14 "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God."

Sunday, June 9th, is Pentecost Sunday, the great day of the Holy Spirit. It commemorates the events recorded in the second chapter of Acts, and serves as a reminder that the Christian life can only be led by the influence and power of the Holy Spirit. Human intent is not enough. The verb translated as "led" in this verse could be translated "are continually being led". It is an ongoing, daily process, and the context indicates that it has to do with the ongoing battle between what we often feel like doing and what we know we ought to do.

Perhaps one response to this is the be aware that we often know what is the right response to life, but following through is the issue. We then determine, as often as we can, that we are going to pursue what we know to be the right course of action, aware that we may not want to do so or feel like doing so. Finally, we do not trust our own willpower, but pray as often as we can (the Bible says to do so continually-1 Thessalonians 5:16). In that way we are well placed to be led by the Holy Spirit. I believe that the Holy Spirit leads us more often than we realize, often without us realizing it. He is the agent of unlimited influence in our lives, and we could not hope to be true disciples of Jesus without Him.
